\* Some clinics work with a private lab which could charge fees for certain tests. Sometimes these are covered by insurance but not always. **To avoid any lab fees:** you can ask for a requisition and then go to a free public lab (for example: a CLSC or hospital).

\* **Are you a teenager?** 14 is the age of medical consent. This means if you're 14+ you can see a doctor without needing your parents' involvement or consent. Young people 14-17 can see a doctor without their parents' permission and they don't need their medicare cards.
